



Individual Education Plan (IEP) Evaluation & Consult

IEPs will be reviewed, present levels tied to goals, S.M.A.R.T. goals written (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Time Defined), IEP meetings attended remotely and recommendations for improvement provided.

Individual In-School Consultation

An intensive learning day for all which include preparation, observation, modeling, practice and debrief. It is important for the entire team that supports the student to be involved and engaged to experience the student's response to alternative strategies and use of aids, tools, and AAC making it possible for the student to participate during instruction, discussions and modeling.



Individual At-Home / Remote Consultation

The in-home/onsite consult includes preparation, observation, modeling, practice in embedding communication, behavioral and learning strategies into the typical home schedule and family debrief. It is important for the entire family to be involved and engaged to experience the kiddos's response to alternative strategies and use of aids, tools, AAC so the family can feel confident in modeling and utilizing new strategies.
